During the current flood it has been seen that majority of the area severely destroyed the most of the infrastructure and displaced more than 20 million population of the District Kamber Shahdadko. So due to this unfortunately the economy of the area has greatly been crippled and peoples are in very worse situation.

Keeping in view the Takhleeq Foundation had focused the flood affected areas through proper assessment followed by providing the basic health services, food and non food items among the communities .In this Connection medical staff and other field staff are working very closely to the community in four affected Talukas of District Kambar Shahdadkot i.e. Kambar, Mirokhan, Warah, Shadadkot & Qubo Saeed Khan. A part from this also provided the wash facilities in 05 tent cities by providing the 100 pit latrines, 20 wash rooms & 10 Hand Pumps

Additionally During the month of December 2010(28th December) Takhleeq Foundation with the support of CIP installed the Water Filter Plant at **Village Sanjhar Khan Jamali**, Taluka Qubo Saeed Khan, This H2O Unlimited water filter plant possesses the approximately capacity of 8000 liters water to supply in 24 hours as per its Catalogue and it is expected that 2500-3000 Peoples can drink the water daily as per WHO Standards.

Through this water filter plant community will get very much relief and this will be highly helpful to avoid the water Born Diseases. This will be beneficial for about 450 families living in Village Sanjhar Khan Jamali the severely flood affected area including an other village namely Abdul Wahab Khoso situated equivalent to this village.

More Over, VWC (Village Water Committee) also has been formed by involving the community elders & youth from those villages including TMA Qubo Saeed Khan in order to ensure proper operations, security, and ownership & sustainability of the Water filter Plant.

How ever, further in this regard MOU (Memorandum of under Standing) is also ready to sign with District Government to acknowledge such support and for its effective & sustainable usage in future as well.

Though, we have found initially some concerns regarding life Span of water filters but still we are looking forward its better usage and may bring the benefit to community.
